Roy Phillamore Memorial Trophies

In loving memory of 'our Roy' we will be presenting four horse/pony rider combinations with a beautiful, Memorial Trophy. Roy was a fantastic ambassador for Weston Lawns and encouraged all those who competed in his Weston Arena to 'have a go'. He constantly encouraged the nervous and those first timers to keep on going and push themselves on to the next level.

We would like to thank all those people who have contributed to purchasing the beautiful trophies, in Roy's memory.

The format; A horse and rider combination may compete in any number of classes, at any height, however only points from a maximum of two classes will count towards the Memorial Trophy points table. **Riders must indicate on their entry form which classes they would like to use to earn points, if they intend to compete in more than two classes. Riders are only eligible for one category.**

*Points will be allocated to each horse and rider combination as follows;
99 - 1st, 88 - 2nd, 79 - 3rd, 68 - 4th, 59 - 5th, 48 - 6th, 39 - 7th, 28 - 8th, 19 - 9th, 8 - 10th
The four categories are as follows (age at 1st January 2017);*

*12 Years and Under
18 Years and Under
35 Years and Under
36 Years and Over*

Top 3 horse/ rider combinations in each category will receive a special rosette and the OVERALL winner also wins Roy's memorial perpetual shield & sash.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All Competitors must become a minimum of a bronze member of Weston Lawns. Membership forms are available on the day from the office. Membership runs 1st Jan to 31st December, annually.
- Prize Money will be dependant on number of starters:
- 5 Starters = 1st Place, 10 Starters = 1st and 2nd Place, 15 Starters = 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place
- All the above classes are open to horses and ponies and classes will be split if entries exceed 20.
- Competitors must ensure that they warm up in the correct collecting ring – please note that we may be running other competitions on the same day, in the interests of safety the collecting rings for each event will be separate. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in elimination.
- Classes will be run under British Showjumping rules – except we will allow 3 refusals.
- Dress for the unaffiliated jumping will be competition wear those taking part in clear round do not need to wear a riding jacket.
- Entries will not be accepted – **under any circumstances** – without payment.
- Prize money will not be paid until payment has been received for entry, and must be collected on the day of competition. Any monies not collected, will be forfeited.
- Children must not be left of the premises unattended!
- Horses and Ponies must not be left tied up to the lorry / trailer.
- Stables must be left clean and tidy with banks up. Only stables booked may be used.
- The expense of any veterinary services rendered either on or after the Show must be born by the competitor or owner of stock.
- If you are competing at Weston Lawns and have travelled alone, you must notify the Secretary and leave contact details in case of an emergency.
- Weston Lawns accept no responsibility for the loss or damage to persons or their property whilst on our premises. It is recommended that all items of value be locked away at all times.
- No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property, servants or anyone in connection with the event. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto.
- The decision of the Judges is final.
- If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries.
- Horse/pony and rider combinations registered with British Showjumping in the current year, are not allowed to compete for the Perpetual Trophies.
