Format of Arena Eventing

Competitors are required to complete both dressage and jumping phase to be competitive. Scores from the dressage will be converted into penalties, which will then be carried forward to the show jumping and cross-country phase. The competitor will complete a show jumping course with penalties being added for knockdowns or refusals in the normal way. After the competitor has finished the show jumping they will proceed immediately into the cross-country phase which will be conducted in the same arena. There will be an optimum time with penalties for going too fast as well as for going too slow.

Faults will be awarded across the course as follows:

Refusal or Knock Down of SJ: 4 Faults

3 refusals at SJ: Elimination

Refusal at XC: 20 Faults

Second refusal at XC: 40 Faults

Third refusal at XC: Elimination

Knock Down of XC: No Faults

Horse or Rider Fall: Elimination

Entry fees and prizes

Prizes; Rosettes in each class, with prizes as follows;

1st £30 Weston Lawns Entries & Tack Shop Voucher (awarded if 5 or more starters)

2nd £20 Weston Lawns Entries & Tack Shop Voucher (awarded if 10 or more starters)

3rd £10 Weston Lawns Entries & Tack Shop Voucher (awarded if 15 or more starters)

Entry fees: £27 per class (includes dressage & jumping phases)

£13 Dressage only (pre-entry)

£16 Jumping only (entry on the day)

Entries close the Wednesday prior to the competition. Late entries may be accepted according to availability; however there will be an additional charge of £5 per horse. Withdrawals made after times have been issued will be charged for in full.

Times: Published on our website (www.westonlawns.co.uk) at 4pm, two days before the competition.

Series league table prizes

At the end of the series the combination gaining the most points **overall** will be awarded prizes in kind, which are to be for 1st to 3rd.

Points: Points will be awarded 1st – 3rd in each class (1st – 3 points, 2nd – 2 points, 3rd – 1 point)

YOU MAY PURCHASE CLEAR ROUND TICKETS FOR ANY OF THE JUMPING PHASES - £16 PER ROUND ON THE DAY

Class 0a – Clear Round (Class 0a 75cm, 1a 80cm, 2a 90cm, 3a 1.00m, 4a 1.05m, 5a 1.10m)

Commencing at 9am PROMPT with a 75cm course. Then, if you just want to come along and do the jumping phase in any of the classes, you can pre-enter or enter on the day at £16 per round (***jumping non competitively***)

Class 1 - Arena Eventing Pre – Intro (Class 1a Jumping ONLY)

Dressage tests; Test BE92 (2009) on all competition dates (see front cover)

Showjumping; Max height 0.80m

Cross-country; 80-85cms (3 or 4 fences approx 85cm, towards end of course)

Class 2 - Arena Eventing Intro (Class 2a Jumping ONLY)

Dressage tests; Test BE91 (2009) on Jan 7th, Feb 25th, March 4th

Test BE95 (2012) on Jan 21st, Feb 4th & 18th, March 11th

Showjumping; Max height 0.90m, majority of fences 85-90cm

Cross-country; 85-90cms (3 or 4 fences approx 95cm, towards end of course)

Class 3 - Arena Eventing Pre Novice (Class 3a Jumping ONLY)

Dressage tests; Test BE102 (2010) on Jan 7th, Feb 25th, March 4th

Test BE106 (2012) on Jan 21st, Feb 4th & 18th, March 11th

Showjumping; Max height 1m, majority of fences 90-95cm

Cross-country; 90cm - 1m (three or four fences approx 1m, towards end of course)

Class 4 - Arena Eventing Novice (Class 4a Jumping ONLY)

Dressage tests Test BE110 (2012) on Jan 21st, Feb 4th & 18th, March 11th

Test BE112 (2010) on Jan 7th, Feb 25th, March 4th

Showjumping; Max height 1.05m, majority of fences 1m-1.05m

Cross-country; Approx 1.00m – 1.05m (three or four fences approx 1.10m, towards end of course)

Class 5 - Arena Eventing Intermediate (Class 5a Jumping ONLY)

Dressage tests Test BE115 (2011) on Jan 21st, Feb 4th & 18th, March 11th

Test BE117 (2009) on Jan 7th, Feb 25th, March 4th

Showjumping; Max height 1.15m, majority of fences 1.10m

Cross-country; Approx 1.10m – 1.15m (three or four fences approx 1.15m, towards end of course)

Class 6 - Advanced Dressage & FEI 1*, 2*, 3*, 4* ONLY (pre-entry Feb 25th, March 4th & 11th Only)

Dressage tests PYO – Feb 25th, March 4th & 11th

Weston Lawns event rules and regulations

- All Competitors must become a minimum of a bronze member of Weston Lawns. Membership forms are available on the day from the office. Membership runs 1st Jan to 31st December, annually.
- Horses do not need to be plaited, however if you wish to do so out of respect for the judge, please feel free to do so.
- Riders must wear a Show Jacket or Hacking Jacket for the dressage. XC colours may be worn in the SJ and XC phases, body protectors and hard hats to PAS015 or EN1384 are mandatory for this section.
- Prizes will be dependant on number of starters:
5 Starters = 1st Place, 10 Starters = 1st and 2nd Place, 15 Starters = 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place
- Competitors must ensure that they warm up in the correct collecting ring – please note that we may be running other competitions on the same day, in the interests of safety the collecting rings for each event will be separate. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in elimination.
- Entries will not be accepted – **under any circumstances** – without payment.
- Prize money will not be paid until payment has been received for entry. Prize money will not be paid until payment has been received for entry, and must be collected on the day of competition. Any monies/vouchers not collected, will be forfeited.
- Children must not be left of the premises unattended!
- Horses and Ponies must not be left tied up to the lorry / trailer.
- Stables must be left clean and tidy with banks up. Only stables booked may be used.
- If you are competing at Weston Lawns and have travelled alone, you must notify the Secretary and leave contact details in case of an emergency.
- Weston Lawns reserve the right to close entries early if full. Entries will be taken on a first come first serve basis.
